

- All levels of the CFA Program transitioned to CBT in 2021
- 4 testing windows (up to 7 days each) annually: February, May, August,
 November
- Self-schedule in exam window
- 400+ testing locations globally in highly secure computer testing centers
- Total testing time is 4.5 hours
